

# Behavioural, developmental and psychological characteristics in children with germline PTEN mutations: A carer report study

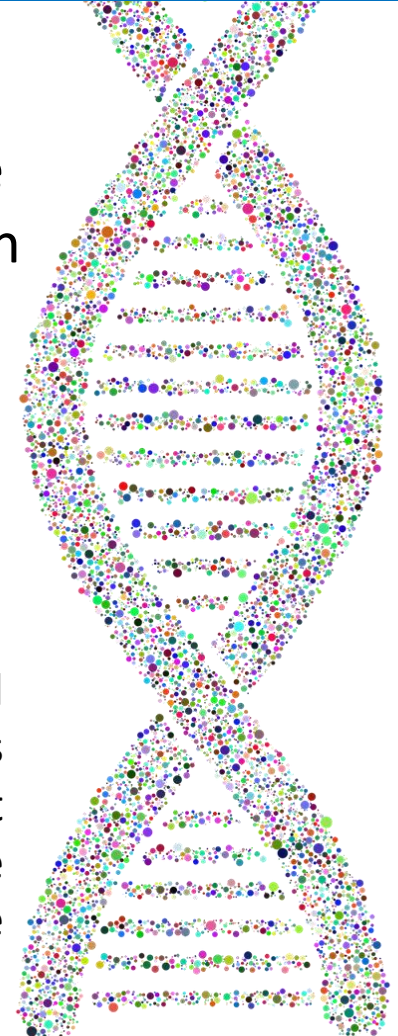
## Participants wanted for an online survey
