Participants:

- A diagnosis of PTEN Syndrome

- Age 3 – 45
- Access to a reliable internet connection

Research Method:

Participants will test new online surveys and webcam measures for PTEN Syndrome from the comfort of home.

Both the online assessment and survey will be given 3 times; at the start of the study, 1-month later, and 4-months later.

Parents will be able to assist any participant who needs help completing the webcam measures.
